

Hello Sunflower State Games Athletes,

We are very grateful to be able to offer competition at this year's sunflower state games between July 10-19. We have worked closely with officials, commissioners and venues to put measures in place to keep everyone as safe as possible and greatly minimize the risk of spreading Coronavirus at this year's events. We are depending on you and those with you to adhere to the guidelines and be patient and show respect to other athletes, officials and our many dedicated volunteers. Now, the general guidelines are as follows:

- **A cloth mask is to be worn by spectators at all times while within a six-foot distance of another person effective at 12:01 a.m. Thursday, July 9th, 2020 per Shawnee County Resolution NO. 2020-44.**
- **Be sure to cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue and to immediately wash your hands or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol and throw the tissue away.**
- **If you are feeling ill or exhibiting any of the symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever or respiratory issues, please do not attend the tournament for the sake of the safety of others.**
- **We ask that you exit the venue in between games to avoid overcrowding at each venue.**
- **Water will not be provided to participants due to the spread of Covid-19. Please bring your own water.**
- **We ask that you bring only immediate family members to your event to limit the number of spectators at each venue.**

Following these guidelines will keep us all safe and healthy and able to have a great Sunflower State Games. Thank you and good luck.
